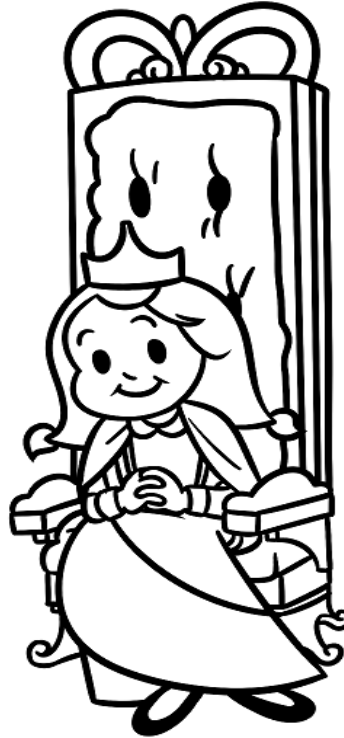

## About Your Spelling Words

At the end of each of your spelling words, you will notice vowel, then a consonant, then a silent-e.

Usually a silent-e is used to change a short vowel sound into a long vowel sound.

Add a silent-e to end of the word *cap* and you make the word *cape*. (Notice that *cap* has a short-a sound. *Cape* has a long-a sound.)
